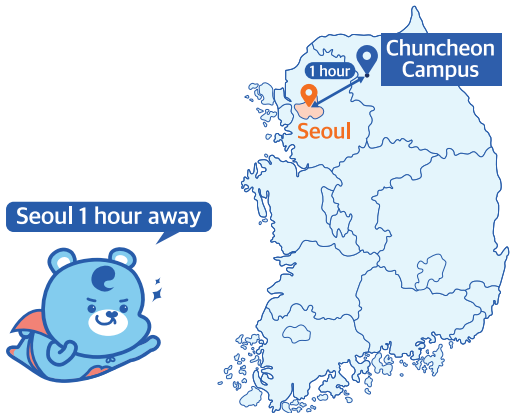
Cultural experience activities

- As a national university, tuition is more affordable compared to other universities, and various Korean cultural experience programs are provided free of charge



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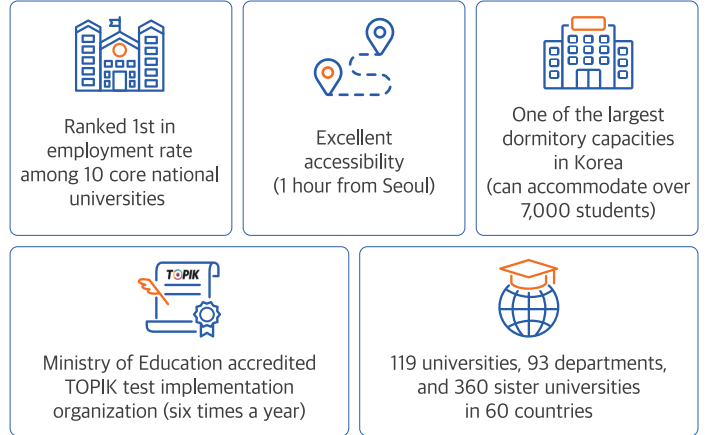

Level	Contents
Level 1 (Beginner)	· Learn basic Korean vowels, vocabulary, and expressions · Basic day to day conversation: self introduction, greetings, etc.
Level 2 (Beginner)	· Basic grammar rules, vocabulary, and expressions · Improve communication ability for daily life and college life conversations
Level 3 (intermediate)	· Learn and use high level vocabulary and more complex grammar · Speak and write opinions using proper grammar and syntax
Level 4 (intermediate)	· Learn idiomatic expressions used in daily life or in specific situations · Learn to logically express the situations in schools and at work places · Express matters related to one's own study / business using specialized terms
Level 5 (advanced)	· Learn and use advanced level grammar rules and vocabulary · Practice writing specialized texts: lecture notes, academic reports, etc. · Logically express one's thoughts and opinions on general social issues
Level 6 (advanced)	· Learn professional knowledge for college-level education · Improve communication ability through discussion and presentation · Improve communication ability for professional fields
